reported a fire at Chile Peppers restaurant or possibly in a home near by. structure fire. Dispatched to: T-1, E-2, E-3, Additionally a male ran up to station 1's engine room and E-4, 3464 and Batt 2 responded to the report Offi pi

visualizing sides A, B, D and a portion of C I found heavy smoke throughout heavy fire behind the windows of side D. appeared to be the entire roof area of 672 Branch. Conditions found: Upon our arrival we found heavy smoke showing Upon walking around from what and

Fire Marshal Maggio assisted investigators and gathered information investigate. the peak of the roof. Later E-2 relieved T-1 on side B. side B and fought fire through the windows, heavy fire was venting from windows. pulled out T-1 hampered by a large amount of pack rat storage. Upo: reported heavy fire venting from sides C and side D. applied front door on -2 had RIC.  $\mathtt{E}\text{-4}$  and  $\mathtt{E}\text{-3}$  deluged sides C and D with preconnects. water ne roof. The fire was knocked down and SLO FIST was called into 3464 with several PCF FFs assisted with overhaul. When through side A. personnel and declared the fire to be defensive only. Batt 2 RIC was in place FF Pratt the windows on Advancing through the front door was slow and difficult, assumed Chile T-1 laddered the roof and cut a vent hole at command. side D. and I attacked the fire from the 田-3 FF Pratt pulled a preconnect Upon E-4's arrival they layed Early into the fire Batt in a supply line to T-1 advanced along At that and
