E-3 responded to the dispatched address for a reported structure fire. Upon arrival E-3 found a well involved commercial structure "The Sub" with heavy brown smoke and fire coming from the A-side. E-3 spotted at the rear of (R/O)the address to set up for offensive fire attack and to soften up the R/O the structure. Sub IC assigned E-3 to control utilities and assume Division "C". E-3 shut-off electrical power to the structure and assigned the GAS Company on scene to shut-off the gas. Next the sliding freight door and man door below the service drop were forced opened for fire attack as well as eggress for interior crews. A 2-1/2" attack line was pulled off E-3 to stop fire spread within the structure. Immediately upon openning the doors at the R/O the structure, heavy black smoke began coming out and high heat levels were noted on the Thermal Imaging Camera (TIC). Next a 2-1/2" attackline was placed into service through the rear man doors to cool the ceiling and prepare for entry. Entry was attempted but not made due to heavy fire involvement at the ceiling level and partial collapse of the ceiling just inside the point of enrty. E-3472 was assigned to assist E-3 with water supply from Walker/Pismo and T-2 forced the last to doors on the C/D side. Shortly after a water supply was established, Chief Olson arrived on scene and took over operations as Division "C". See Chief Olson's narrative for further information.
